Our visit to Derby Cathedral **By the School Council**

"We did a treasure hunt at Derby Cathedral. In the treasure hunt we had to find a wallet with our school name on it. In the wallet was all the things you need to debate. There was a picture of all the things you need for a debate and the name of it too and you need to match them. I was very surprised about what things you need for a debate. It was very fun.

Next we had a debate. It was about sugar tax. We had to vote about if children under 12 should pay £2.50 from their pocket money to the government for eating too many sweets. 28 people voted yes and 112 voted no.

Finally we did some work on modern slavery. We learnt lots of new things like that there are over 36 million slaves in the world. There was also a story about 24 men living in one small house which contained two beds, one bathroom and two downstairs rooms and are rushed out to and from work every day. They get paid £5 a week and have been living like this for 3½ years, they have only just been discovered. After learning all of these facts we were set to make a poster to persuade people to stop slavery. Later on we had a speech from the Bishop and were sent home. We all had a great time enjoyed ourselves and learnt lots."
