### **HEAD TEACHER'S UPDATE**

The Lottery grant for the Tyre Park and Climbing Wall is going ahead.

Costs are awaited for the repairs to the tarmac, shelving and trim trail posts. It was approved that the PTFA would fund these.

There is the possibility of involvement in helping to repair the path up Mam Tor. This could be linked to a family PTFA event such as a walk or cycle.

The request for £150 for new books for Hedgehog and Owls was approved. £150 has been kindly donated from Eyam Book Barn, many thanks to the Book Barn.

£150.00 towards the "Just Different" workshop was approved.

£550.00 towards the Chocolate workshop was approved. This is to be held within school to save on coach travel costs and involves all the children.
