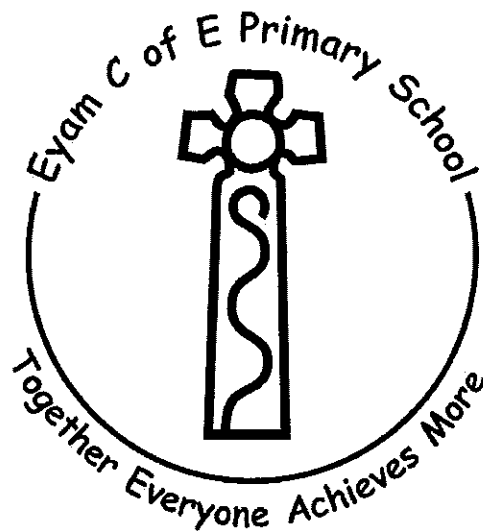

### Governors Charging & Remissions Policy

The main intention of the Governing body is that no child should be deprived of an educational opportunity because a parent or carer may not be able to cover the cost.

Pupils whose parents receive income support or income based job-seekers allowance may be eligible for a discount. The school asks families who are in receipt of the Pupil Premium funding to make a reduced voluntary contribution to trips.

We will ask parents for a voluntary contribution but no pupil will be excluded because they have not paid the full amount.

Lessons, Materials & Equipment	Policy
Ordinary day to day supply of materials and resources.	These are free.
Instrumental music lesson in school time.	Parents will be charged for these but the governors <u>may</u> decide to support a child who would benefit from lessons whose parents or carers have genuine reasons for not being able to pay themselves.
Damage to or loss of books or equipment.	Parents may be charged for replacements if the damage or loss is not accidental.
Trips or activities which are wholly or mainly in school time.	Parents will be asked for voluntary contributions, but no pupil will be excluded from going because of an inability to pay. Often the balance is paid for by the PTA.
Activities which are not part of the National Curriculum, eg residential visits	Parents will be asked to meet the full cost, but on request, consideration will be given to supporting children in financial need.

With regard to specific activities, eg photocopying the school will refer to the rates provided by the LA.
